MINUTES

The Anna-Jonesboro Community High School held its regular meeting on May 15, 2017. Upon roll call at 7:00 p.m. the following members were present: Mrs. Teske, Dr. Reach, Mr. Hughey, Dr. Blakely, Mr. McGrath, and Mrs. Boget. Also present was Superintendent Wright and Brett Detering.

On motion by Mrs. Boget and seconded by Mrs. Blakely to approve the Agenda as written. All members present voting yes.

On motion by Mr. Hughey and seconded by Dr. Reach to appoint Doug Edwards as Board Member to fill vacancy and serve until the next regular board election. On roll call, all members present voting yes. Motion carried

Hannah Maze Student Council advisor represented the Student Council. The items presented were as follows:

Madi Bigler and Kenzi Boget were awarded 500.00 each from the American Red Cross. We receive a scholarship from the Red Cross for hosting our 3 blood drives. The scholarship is based off of how many donors we receive. We are hoping to use this as an incentive in future blood drives. Student Council donated 500.00 towards Safe Celebration. Student Council also donated 600.00 towards the rose bushes and flowers that were planted up here by the superintendent's office. Meeting Friday to discuss theme for homecoming. Looking at once upon a time or Hawaiian (luau) theme.

Alisha Bottje represented the teachers. The items of interest presented were as follows:

Ms. Neitzer's classes would like to thank the Board and Administration for many field trip opportunities this year. Dual credit ecology students worked hard during numerous stewardship days around the school, at a local farm, and at the Cache Wetlands. They also enjoyed touring a local sustainable cabin and a local mushroom farm, and canoed the Cache and tested water quality. Instead of traveling to Logan Chiropractic College this year, dual credit biology students spent the day at SIUC. They toured a biochemistry lab focusing on ALS, the awesome greenhouses, and finally the School of Medicine. The School of Medicine tour included 3 stations: 1) anatomy staff and med students reviewed different organs from the cadaver lab with

the students, 2) medical students showing the high school students how to do a physical exam using a stethoscope, ophthalmoscope, otoscope, etc, 3) they ran through a mock patient case like they would do in a group session during year one of medical school. It was an incredible experience. SIUC staff was very impressed by our students and has invited us to attend again in future years. The Math Team competed at SEMO Math Field Day on April 18th. Abby Sartin received 2nd place in Algebra 1, the Algebra 1 Team received a 2nd place, and Soren Poulas Keller received 3rd place in Non-Routine Problem Solving.

Principal Detering discussed SAT scores.

Superintendent Wright presented his administrative report on the uncertainty of state funding. He also went over the findings from the state fire marshal's report; there were only a few minor violations, many of which will be corrected by the installation of the new fire alarm system this summer. Our 5 year waiver to allow out of district employees' children to attend our district without paying tuition was approved. Our new District Vision Team had its first meeting on May 5th, and was well received from all parties. Registration will begin for the Triple I Conference in June; anyone wishing to attend will need to let us know.
