MINUTES

The Anna-Jonesboro Community High School held its regular meeting on November 21, 2016. Upon roll call at 7:00 p.m. the following members were present: Mr. Housman, Dr. Reach, Mr. Hughey, Dr. Blakely, Mr. Edwards, Mr. McGrath, and Mrs. Boget. On motion by Dr. Reach and seconded by Mrs. Boget to approve the Agenda as written. All members present voting yes. Motion carried

On motion by Mrs. Boget and seconded by Dr. Blakely to approve the Consent Agenda that includes approval of board meetings on 10/17/2016, approval of closed session minutes, approval of payment of bills, acceptance of financial reports. On roll call, all members present voting yes. Motion carried.

Madison Bigler represented Student Council:

Our blood drive on Dec 19th was a huge success. We had 79 individuals signed up for the blood drive, we had 11 walk ins from the community, and we were able to exceed our goal of 62 and had 69 units that we collected. Our next blood drive will be in January, we will begin planning that blood drive when we get back from Christmas break. We are continuing our support of the Pay It Forward program and we are "adopting" 10 children this year for Christmas. We went shopping last Wednesday and are excited to present these to the organization.

Mrs. Houseman represented the teachers. The items of interest presented were as follows:

The AJ Marching Band took first place in the Caroll P Foster Veterans Parade in Anna. The marching band will also be performing in the Lights Fantastic Parade on Dec 3rd in Carbondale. The Concert Choir will record a performance for the WSIL Sounds of the Season program, which will air on channel 3 during the Christmas holiday. The Music Department will hold its Winter Concert on Tuesday Dec. 13th in the Auditorium. This is a free concert open to the public and all are invited to attend.

Kelli Wood came and talked to Ms. Bottje's seniors and finances and money management.

The NHS collected items for the New Coats, New Hope campaign during the last week of October. Students could also donate a dollar to wear their Halloween costume to school. On Halloween night they held a trick or treating event to collect items and have an outreach opportunity to children in the community. This was a very successful event. Over \$180.00 was raised and several coats, socks, and other items were collected.
